1 1 Section 1. LEAD WHEEL WEIGHTS STUDY. The department of
1 2 natural resources shall conduct a study regarding the
1 3 environmental benefits and cost=effectiveness of prohibiting
1 4 the use of lead wheel weights in the state. By January 1,
1 5 2010, the department shall submit a written report to the
1 6 governor and the general assembly providing the findings of
1 7 the study and making recommendations.

1 8 EXPLANATION

1 9 This bill requires the department of natural resources to
1 10 conduct a study regarding the environmental benefits and
1 11 cost=effectiveness of prohibiting the use of lead wheel
1 12 weights in the state. By January 1, 2010, the department is
1 13 required to submit a written report to the governor and the
1 14 general assembly providing the findings of the study and

1 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 321.447 LEAD WHEEL WEIGHTS.
1 2 1. A person shall not offer for sale in this state a motor
1 3 vehicle equipped with lead wheel weights.
1 4 2. In the servicing, repair, or maintenance of a motor
1 5 vehicle, lead wheel weights shall not be installed.
1 6 3. In the servicing, repair, or maintenance of a motor
1 7 vehicle, lead wheel weights shall be replaced with wheel
1 8 weights composed of materials other than lead.
1 9 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect July 1,
1 10 2010.

EXPLANATION

1 11 This bill prohibits the sale in this state a motor vehicle
1 12 equipped with lead wheel weights. During the servicing,
1 13 repair, or maintenance of a motor vehicle, the bill prohibits
1 14 the installation of wheel weights and requires such wheel
1 15 weights to be replaced with wheel weights composed of
1 16 materials other than lead.
1 17 The bill takes effect July 1, 2010.
